Effective for 2020**

We patiently wait for the State of Connecticut to announce the Phase 3 Reopening Plan, and changes in the Covid 19 restrictions. In accordance with the State's limitations related to gatherings, PRGC is forced continue to restrict our indoor activities. We will continue to watch for updated guidelines and will announce any changes via our website.

CT State guidelines still restricts indoor gatherings to 25 people. With these limitations to gatherings, PRGC for the safety of our membership, **will not hold a general**

membership meeting in October.

We will hold a Executive Board meeting on 09/29/2020.

Attendance will be restricted to Board members only due to the CT State group size restrictions.

Our current PRGC Rules and Restrictions are as followed;

- The Clubhouse restroom is open to members.
- PRGC does not provide any PPE but please properly dispose of any PPE items you have used.
